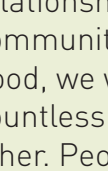

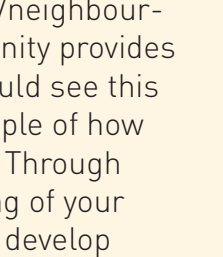
WE ARE THERE FOR EACH OTHER

WHY IS OUR FOCUS ON THE TOPIC NEIGHBOURHOOD?

Neighbourhood is a topic that everyone has to face sooner or later in life and we can deal with it one way or another. Feeling comfortable in your own home/neighbourhood and the resulting community provides a higher quality of life. You should see this community picture as an example of how living together could work out. Through communicating and questioning of your own role in this community we develop mutual understanding and the "Verein Sozialsprengel" is taking on the role of a mediator. It is there to help answer any sort of questions that evolve around the topic of living together in a neighbourhood. Projects that already exist like the App 'Use what you have' (hard.usewhatyouhave.at) can be supported through that, the platform simplifies communication for giving away or borrowing objects that aren't used on a daily basis. Sharing of knowledge or talents can also be provided and through mutual sharing within a neighbourhood you can quite often save acquisition costs, or does every household in Hard really need a toolbox, "Raclette-Set" or their own library?
